

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


**IQAC Report: 2023-24**

The IQAC prepared the college's academic calendar for the year 2023-24 based on the academic calendar of the affiliated university. Various College Committees were formed to conduct programs and activities on the campus throughout the year. The College Magazine 'Vagvina-2023-24' was published containing articles written by the teachers and the students of the college. As mentioned in the Academic Calendar: 2023-24, the IQAC organized the following activities in the institute-

The first academic session started on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023 and ended on 27<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2023. The work of the admission committee began on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023. The Induction Program and Bridge Courses were organized for the FY students in August. Birth/Death Anniversaries of the great souls were celebrated according to the academic calendar. NEP-Awareness workshops/ programs were organized for the college students and staff. The Ecofriendly Rakhi Competition and the Wild-Vegetable Exhibition were organized. Study tours, field visits, and institutional visits were organized to expose our students to new environments and developmental activities. Four new courses were started at PG level in Botany, Zoology, Mathematics, and Physics. Mahatma Fule Lecture Series was organized on 28<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2023. Department of Chemistry Organized Poster Competition on the occasion of International Ozone Day. The Holi Natural Colour Making Competition was organized. Faculty of Commerce & Management observed National Consumer Rights Day on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2023. The Computer Science Department organized a workshop on Fundamentals of ICT Tools and MS Office. Library Department observed Right to Information Week from 06/10/2023 to 12/10/2023 on the occasion of International Right to Information Day. Regular Teachers and CHB Teachers of the department of Marathi visited various high schools in the area and engaged classes as the best practice of the department under 'The Job Training Program; also observed 'Raj-Bhasha Din'. NCC cadets actively participated in 'AzadiKa Amrut Mahtasove' and 'Har Ghar Tiranga' Abhiyan. Organized Cleanliness Drive on 14/08/2023 and Road Safety Abhiyan'. NCC Cadets participated in 'Runs for Unity' on the occasion of 'Rashtriya Ekata' divas on dated 31/10/2023. Celebrated International Yoga Day on 21<sup>st</sup> June. Department of Political Science observed Information Rights Day, Human Rights Day,

and Savidhan Divas; and organized awareness programs for the new voters. Students of the department visited the Grampanchayat of Surali to study the workings of the Panchayat.

The Admission Committee meeting was organized to discuss the admission process for FY (NEP) students for the year 2024-25. Induction Program was organized from 21<sup>st</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 in the college to create awareness amongst the FY students about the college infrastructure, facilities and courses, Games and sports, Library etc. Information regarding changes in the education policy, NEP-2020, was given to the students. According to the guidelines of the affiliated university, the college established a “Grievance Cell’ on the campus under ‘The Students Grievance Redressal Committee’. A committee was formed to examine the GOEC-07 (Soft Skill for Personality Development) paper of FY- B. A., B. Com. and B. Sc. students. A proposal, under the Career Katta, was submitted for the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Fund. Farewell and Felicitation Programs, on the occasion of the college employee retirement, were organized. The College Purchase Committee was reorganized, and the equipment, glassware, chemicals, stationery, and furniture were purchased. The Coordinators of the Equal Opportunity Cell, Career Counseling and Guidance Cell, Placement Cell and the Music, Arts and Cultural Cell participated in the District Level Workshop organized by the affiliated university. Vide the Govt. of Maharashtra Lette, General Administration Department No. GAD-49022/14/2023-GAD (DESK-29) dt. 27/12/2023 College observed Birth/Death Anniversaries of the Great Souls/ Freedom Fighters were celebrated on the campus.

To improve the teaching-learning process, the college purchased the ‘White Boards’ for the classrooms in the new G+4 building and also for the old building from Nandini Enterprises, Amravati. The post of Contributory Hand Basis Teacher was filled according to the guidelines of the affiliated university. To complete the ‘Internship’ of the students (according to NEP-2020 guidelines), an Internship Committee/ Cell was established on the campus. The students of Post Graduate Courses in Arts, Commerce, and Science completed the Internship. Students’ educational tours/ field visits/ industrial visits/ Institutional Visits were organized to make them aware of the outside world.



A one-day Workshop on “Stock Register Maintenance” was organized on 9<sup>th</sup> Jan., 2024 in the college for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. Shri Milind Malve, Senior Laboratory Assistant, Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati was the speaker of this workshop. To create awareness and to provide information about the changes in education policy due to NEP-2020, the School Connect Programme-2024 was organized on 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 in the college vide guidelines of the affiliated university (Letter No. SGBAU/IQAC/13/2024, dt. 13<sup>th</sup> Jan., 2024). The IQAC Coordinator and the Senior & Junior College Staff members were also present for the program.

No. 1-1/2023 (Environmental Education), dt. 24<sup>th</sup> Jan., 2024, the awareness program was organized regarding the participation of students in the “GO4- Youth Olympiad” organized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi under the NEP 2020 to educate students about acquiring Knowledge and Skills in Environmental Education. The College Social Gathering was organized between 27<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2024. Educational, and Cultural programs, Competitions, and Games and Sports were organized on the campus. The winner student participants were felicitated with prizes and medals.

The Principal, Dr. G. N. Chaudhari, and the IQAC Coordinator, Dr. S. v. Satpute attended the One-Day Workshop on “Cluster University: A New Model For Higher Education” at Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati on date 12/2/2024. The Vice Chancellor of Affiliated University Dr. Milind Barahate; Shri Harshvardhan Deshmukh, President, Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati were the guest for the inaugural function. Dr. D. K. Mhaske and Dr. Vijaykumar Kumbhar of Karmveer Bhaurao Patil University, Satara were the guest speakers. They talked about the legal framework of cluster universities and related topics of interest. IQAC and Office staff attended the Online One Day Workshop regarding AISHE portal data submission on 23/2/2024, and successfully uploaded the data of All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2022-23. The late Sitaramji Chaudhari Memorial Lecture Committee organized a memorial lecture on 7/3/2024. Dr. Hemant Khadke, PGTD, SGBAU was the guest.
